



Bed Bug Control

Dear Homeowner:

This letter details the process and guidelines to control your current bed bug infestation. It is very important that all details are followed as directed for your service technician to complete a thorough application. Please read the following:

- **All clutter must be put into a plastic bag and sealed and contained to one confined area (NOT in an un-infested area)**
- **All electrical outlets and switch plates be removed prior to treatment**
- **All clothing articles must be off the floor and put into a plastic bag and sealed. (NOT in an un-infested area)**
- **It is highly recommended to wash and dry (hot dryer) all clothing items and linens (any items that are dry cleaned. RREXT recommends that dry cleaner is informed of possible bed bugs).**
- **Structure must be vacated for 4 hours from the time of our arrival.**
- **It is important to thoroughly inspect yourself before leaving to make sure the bed bugs are not being transported.**

The treatment includes initial service with (1) weekly follow up service. A thorough inspection will commence prior to treatment. If bed bug infestation is still present then treatment will resume. If at the time of inspection a bed bug infestation is not identified then treatment will cease and service will be completed.
